School-Managed Device Options:

1 . PARENT IN THE ROOM STRATEGY

- Students work at the kitchen table, or in the same room as a parent, not alone in a bedroom.
- Make Homework “Visible”. Students to sit facing outward rather than toward a wall. Parents can easily see the screen when walking past. This creates gentle accountability.
- Parents don’t need to supervise constantly, just being nearby dramatically reduces drifting into games or YouTube.

2. LEARN AND USE YOUR HOME ROUTER CONTROLS

Most routers include parental control settings that allow parents to:

- *Block certain websites (create a list of sites they can’t access in study periods)*
- *Restrict or pause internet access at certain times*
- *Control individual devices*

Because the block happens through the internet connection, it doesn’t matter whether the laptop is school-managed. Need to ensure mobile phone is not near so can’t hotspot instead.
