Syllabus content:	Unleashing Creativity	A Hero's Journey		Drama Study
Learning focus:	By exploring the work of contemporary poets and experimenting with different forms of poetry, students develop a sense of personal style and learn how to express ideas about their own identity. They reflect on their own responses to poetry and consider how particular poems have inspired their own work	Through a close study of the novel <i>The Hunger Games</i> by Suzanne Collins alongside the film, <i>Whale Rider</i> directed Niki Caro, students learn how a study of the hero's journey inspires readers to reflect on their own narrative journey, strengthening identity and wellbeing.		Through a close study of the play <i>Blood Brothers</i> by Willy Russell, students will explore the global context of Identities and Relationships. Students will navigate the world of protagonists and interrogate, provide evidence for, and support a perspective on the way that texts can deliver salient lessons relating to coming of age.
